

Ceilidh Christmas Lights

In some pictures you may notice white Christmas lights woven around the cabin hand rails on each side. We add these each holiday season for ambiance. They provide a soft, pleasant lighting. 2 fifty light strings on 16' cords run forward on the rail, across the boat behind the mast, held in place by the teak strips that close over the ceiling panels (Use a small wire tie around the cord, loosen the teak strip, slip the end of the wire tie under and re tighten, then cut off the protruding tail of the wire tie.) Plug the two strings together behind the mast and plug in the male end into the 110 socket behind the TV
